## Progress scores 2017

These scores show how much progress pupils at Prettygate Junior School made between the end of Key Stage 1 and the end of Key Stage 2, compared to pupils across England who got similar results at the end of Key Stage 1. Most schools have progress scores between -5 and +5.

Progress scores should be interpreted with caution. In common with other junior schools, our attainment is high yet our progress appears less good. Furthermore, if children with specific complex difficulties are removed from our results, then our progress across the board is at the very least broadly average.
